

1378 (ROME): Pope Gregory XI dies; 11 French/5 other cardinals meet and elect Urban VI (Italian); French cardinals leave Rome; alleges forces by Roman mob to elect Urban VI

1406 (FRANCE): French cardinals elect Clement VII; Urban VI *excommunicates* "anti-pope" and French Cardinals

Europe is in *Schism*

1406 (PARIS): Univ faculty: Calls for end of Schism
1409 (PISA): French/Italian cardinals meet; Gregory XII
(Pope) and Benedict (anti-pope) attend; refused to
accept authority of gathering; both excommunicated
by Cardinals; Cardinals elect another anti-popeAlexander V (dies after 11 months); John XXIII elected
to replace him (lives in Pisa)

1414 (Council of Constance); John XXIII leaves city when saw he would not be confirmed as pope; Gregory XII (True Pope) abdicated, Benedict XIII refused to step down (Council deposed him)
1417 (Martin V elected Pope
