

Difference between Charisms and Natural Talent Natural Talent Born with it; inherited; *luck of the draw?* Can be used for good or evil Nothing to do with God

Charisms

Cannot be inherited Supernaturally powered Dependent upon grace Cannot be used for evil Connected to and grows as our relationship with God grows



Talent or Charism?

Talent

...a special **natural ability** or aptitude <u>Charism</u>

... gifts of the Holy Spirit that are given to every baptized Christian that enable them to accomplish things for God above and beyond our natureal human abilities



The Inventory

> While Charisms are REAL, **DISCERNMENT** is NOT! > Only way to DISCERN it to DO and let GOD DO! Higher scores than others does NOT mean you are more gifted! > Three signs of a Charism: *personal experiences*, objective effectiveness for the Kingdom of GOD,

and positive feedback of others, both direct and indirect, should be consistent...

Gifts Discernment

- Important for each person to discern and have knowledge of own charisms
- Discernment is *always* necessary
- Charisms should be received with gratitude and consolation
- Prevents us from judging ourselves because we are not like others
- Helps us avoid burn-out, ineffectiveness, frustration and judging others because they are not like us



Gifts Discernment (cont'd)

Know God

The person who does not pray, cannot discern at all. Our reason for being is because of God and who better to tell us His will and how we were created, then He Himself.

- Prayer: daily, regular times of prayer or a variety of
 - Reflective, quiet presence
 - Scriptural reading
 - Contemplation, listening to God within oneself in love



What difference do Charisms make?

- Charisms of individual Christians make a difference in secular society*
- Charisms allow God's love and care to reach others
- Charisms provide means to reveal Christ to others
- Charisms manifest when our relationship to God becomes *personal;* when we experience the *fruit* of discipleship
